



o **The System for licensing import and export of Ozone Depleting Substances.(Decision IX/8)**

- The Republic of Korea issued the 「Act of Control on the Production etc of Specific Substances for the Protection of The Ozone Layer」 in 1991. According to the Act, all ODS importers, exporters, producers must have a license from the Ministry of Commerce, Industry and Energy(MOCIE).
- The import of CFC-11, CFC-12 was prohibited in 1992 except for MDIs use.
- The Republic of Korea has established and implemented a system for licensing import and export of Ozone Depleting Substances in Annexes A, B, E from 1st January 1992. As for Annex C, Republic of Korea will establish and implement a system for licensing import and export from 1st January 2005 in accordance with the Article 4B paragraph 2 of the Montreal Protocol.

o **Halon Management(Reduction of Emission and Phaseout of Halon)(Decision X/7)**

- The import of all types of halons was prohibited in 1992.
- The Republic of Korea will reduce 50% the production of halons by 2005. To implement this target, Republic of Korea has reduced the production of halons by 9.9% per year since 1999.

- Production and import of new ozone depleting substances

  - BCM(BromoChloroMethane,  $\text{CH}_2\text{BrCl}$ ), n-PB( $\text{C}_3\text{H}_7\text{Br}$ ), Halon-1202 ( $\text{CF}_2\text{Br}_2$ )
  - The Republic of Korea has no production and import of these substances .
